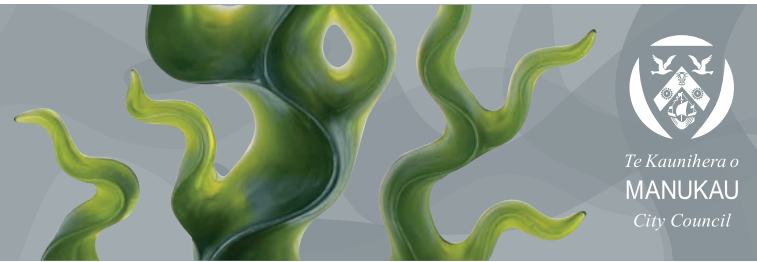

### WHAKATAUAKI

Kua whakawahia koe  
Ki te akatea o tika  
Te pono, me te aroha

You have been infused  
With the knowledge and skills  
To do what is right  
With faith and love

Each year OBJECTive takes on a new theme to guide submitting artists in developing their work. This year's theme comes from a whakatauaki, or Maori proverb, telling the story of Tawhaki's ascent into an upper heaven to bring the gifts of the arts back down to earth. Tawhaki's grandmother advises him and his brother not to take hold of swinging vines on the journey, only those vines that are rooted in the land. His brother, being impatient, grabs a vine that is not attached to the land and perishes. Tawhaki's ascent is assured but his brother's impatience has cost him his life.

The story tells us how art is a gift, a skill and a craft that requires patience and dedication guided by Tika (doing what is right), Pono (faith) and above all else Aroha (humility and love).

### ENTRY DETAILS

Entries open from Friday 24 - Sunday 26 September

Late entries will not be accepted

### WHO CAN ENTER

Emerging and established artists and designers are invited to submit new works of object art. From the handmade to the highly designed, works in ceramics, glass, jewellery, wood, metalwork and textiles are welcomed. The entry should demonstrate this year's whakatauaki as above.

### WHY ENTER

Now in its fourth year, the OBJECTive Art Awards 2010 offer prize money of \$9500 for object art entries. Works selected for exhibition by the judging panel will be displayed at the brand new Mangere Arts Centre, opening on 3 September 2010. The OBJECTive exhibition will also be part of the 2010 Manukau Festival of Arts.

### ENTRY FEE

The entry fee for each artwork is \$20 and is non-refundable.

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All entries must:

- Be of a high standard, quality and finish
- Clearly demonstrate a concept in line with the competition theme/whakatauaki
- Have been completed within the last 12 months
- Be for sale. A commission of 25% will be added to the artist's price
- Remain the property of the artist if unsold
- Be available for purchase by Manukau City Council at its discretion
- Be able to remain on display for the full duration of the exhibition
- Be accompanied by a high-resolution photo of the artwork for possible use in the exhibition catalogue, should your work be selected for exhibition
- Fit within the maximum dimensions of 1.5m high by 1m wide
- Be easily lifted by two people. Size, sturdiness and ease of transport should be considered when submitting your entry
- Have adequate fastenings attached for hanging if relevant
- Be clearly labelled and securely packaged. It is the responsibility of the artist to arrange insurance for the work(s) from the time of initial dispatch through to its return.

### SELECTION

Selection of artworks for exhibition will be at the discretion of the judging panel. The decision of the panel will be final and no discussion or correspondence will be entered into. Artists will be notified of whether their work will be included in the exhibition by email or post.

### RETURN OF ARTWORKS

#### Unsuccessful works

- May be collected from the new Mangere Arts Centre between Sunday 10 and Tuesday 12 October
- Will be dispatched by courier by 15 October if a pre-paid ticket has been supplied.

#### Exhibited works

- May be collected from the new Mangere Arts Centre between Thursday 14 and Saturday 16 November
- Will be dispatched by courier by 19 November if a pre-paid ticket has been supplied.

### CHECKLIST

- Clearly label your art work. List artist's name, title of work and artist's price.
- Complete the Entry Form (photocopies will be accepted).
- Enclose \$20 fee per entry. Please make cheques payable to Manukau City Council.
- Enclose pre-paid NZ Courier ticket (unless collecting in person).
- Include a CD with a high-resolution photograph of your art work.
- Place the Entry Form inside an envelope and securely attach it to the outside packaging of your art work. This also applies to works being delivered in person.
