Conditions of Entry for All AWARDS Please read – Important!

- All work must be original and the sole work of the exhibitor, not copied and not done in a class of instruction
- All work must have been completed between October 2009 and October 2010
- All work must be signed and all work submitted must be for sale
- Entry fee is \$15 per entry, with a maximum of two entries per category (i.e. two for sculpture and two for art awards)
No refunds will be given
- The works and titles of works submitted are as entered. No alterations will be accepted. **Wet work will not be accepted**
- Each artwork must be clearly identified on the back AND on a swing tag which must be able to hang over the front of the work
On the **swing tag; write artist's name, phone number, title of work, medium and price.** D rings are essential
Works that do not include these requirements will not be accepted
- Insurance** to and from CEAC, ProjectSpace and the Studio, and for the duration of the exhibition is the **responsibility of the artist.**
While all care will be taken with work, neither Waitakere Central Community Arts Council nor Waitakere Trust will accept responsibility for loss or damage while work is in transit or while being exhibited
- All work is subject to selection by the judge. The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into
- Artists will be notified if works have been selected by post or e-mail. Unselected works will be exhibited and for sale in the Old St Michaels Church adjacent to the WTAA exhibition. Artists withdrawing unselected work must notify WCCAC by Wed 3rd Nov. 10am
- All works exhibited must remain on display for the duration of the exhibition
Work can NOT be picked up before 4pm Sunday 14 Nov 2010
- Commission on work sold is 30% of the sale price (incl GST). **Personal tax liability is the responsibility of the artist**
- Collection of work is the responsibility of the exhibitor and/or purchaser
Work not collected by the 1st of December 2010 will become the property of the Waitakere Central Community Arts Council and may be sold to defray expenses
- Waitakere Central Community Arts Council and Waitakere Trust reserve the right to photograph and publish any entries in such media as they see fit for these or subsequent art awards
- All entrants must be over 18 years of age as at 1/10/2010

Additional conditions of entry for Waitakere Trust Art Award

- Work must be two-dimensional. Accepted media: oil, acrylic, pastels, watercolour, ink, pencil, crayon, gouache, charcoal, pen, chalk, collage and mixed media
- Entries shall have at least 40% paint content. This does not apply to dry art
- Photography, digital and computer media, computer enhancement or prints can not be entered in this competition
- Each side of any work must not exceed 1220mm, including the frame**
Oversized work will not be accepted. No minimum size
- The winning entry becomes the property of **WAITAKERE TRUST**

Additional conditions of entry for Lincoln Green Sculpture Awards

- Sculpture may be of any material
- Dimensions must not exceed 2000 mm in height and 1500mm in any other direction
The Sculpture must be of a weight easily handled by two people
- All sculptures must be free-standing
